

Speech-Language Pathologist – Community Outreach Program

This position of Speech-Language Pathologist – CORP will provide the therapy sessions, communication assessments, screenings, and co-treatments onsite. The speech-language pathologist may also conduct Inclusion/Integrated Playgroups, assist with the after school programs, and Weekend Adventure Series for participants in the Community Outreach Program. The Speech-Language Pathologist – CORP reports to the Director and/or CORP Manager.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Areas of responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Learn and implement DIR principles in daily interactions with students
- Facilitate play as directed
- Prepare and implement session plans based on the communication needs of the child
- Create and implement schedules for students
- Maintain an organized environment
- Complete data logs and parent communication logs
- Videotape students for evaluation and training purposes
- Maintain stock and inventory
- Attend staff meetings and in-services
- Provide input to other staff regarding communication-related aspects to all activities
- Follow behavior plans (as needed)
- Maintain and use materials such as communication devices, schedules, sensory equipment
- Lead therapeutic activities and co-treatments
- Participate in IEP and profile creation
- Implement therapeutic activities addressing individual goals

Qualifications:

- Master's Degree in Speech-Language Pathology and/or Communication Sciences and Disorders; Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC); CA State License
- 3-5 yrs. experience with children with autism or related issues
- Ability to manage other professionals in a positive and supportive way
- Strong knowledge base of child development, individual learning styles, and demonstrate the ability to work with children who have varied skills
- Experience assessing/evaluating children to create learning opportunities according to their individual needs
- Perform other duties within the scope of employment and certification that may be assigned
