

Special Educator – Community Outreach Program

This position of Special Educator – CORP will provide Floortime sessions, conduct Inclusion/Integrated Playgroups, assist with the after school programs, and Weekend Adventure Series for participants in the Community Outreach Program.

This position may also bridge the services provided in the Community Outreach Program and those offered as part of The Creekside School. At times, this position may work to assist the Teacher/SLP/OT in a multitude of areas such as preparation and implementation of daily activities, maintenance of records and communication logs, and overall maintenance of students well being when called upon. The Special Educator – CORP reports to the Director and/or CORP Manager.

Duties and Responsibilities:

Areas of responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Learn and implement DIR principles in daily interactions with students
- Facilitate play as directed
- Prepare experience-based, multisensory lesson plans/activities
- Create and implement schedules for students
- Maintain an organized environment
- Complete data logs and parent communication logs
- Videotape students for evaluation and training purposes
- Maintain stock and inventory
- Attend staff meetings and in-services
- Provide input in curriculum planning/developing activities
- Follow behavior plans (as needed)
- Maintain and use materials such as communication devices, schedules, sensory equipment
- Participation in therapeutic activities
- Participate in IEP and profile creation
- Implement therapeutic activities addressing individual goals

Qualifications:

Education, training and/or work experience to demonstrate possession of the following knowledge, skills and abilities:

- Mild to Moderate or Moderate to Severe Teaching Credential
- 3-5 yrs. experience with children with autism or related issues
- Ability to manage other professionals in a positive and supportive way
- Strong knowledge base of child development, individual learning styles, and demonstrate the ability to work with children who have varied skills
- Experience assessing/evaluating children to create learning opportunities according to their individual needs
- Perform other duties within the scope of employment and certification that may be assigned
